This annual report reflects statistics beginning on January 1 and ending on December 31, 2013.

In 2013, the department was made up of a Chief, Sergeant, 10 sworn Police Officer positions and a civilian Records Manager; total of thirteen (13) full-time employee positions (during the year, a vacancy in the position of police officer lasted three months).

The department's Patrol Officers worked 12-hour shifts, covering the city 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. At least two officers were regularly scheduled to be on duty 24 hours per day, but that is not always the case, as Holidays, Vacation, Training Days, and Sick Leave have to be factored in. **During 2013, two temporary vacancies had an affect on the Dept's overall output: an Officer resigned to take a job with another agency leaving us short one patrol officer for about 3 months; a second officer experienced a catastrophic illness requiring his absence for more than a month.

The highlights are as follows:

- There were 9,191 police events in 2013 compared to 9,959 in 2012. July was the busiest month with 933; December had the fewest with 587. Calls include self-initiated activities engaged in by the Officers. With a patrol vacancy for more than 3 months and a prolonged illness of more than a month experienced by another patrol officer, the total number of events was lower than the previous year.
- Burglar Alarm/Open Door calls totaled 348 or 3.8% of all calls for service. Of the 348 total, **345 (99%) were false alarms.**
- 8.2% of the total activities required a written report by the responding officer. There were 599 incident reports: the month of May was the busiest for reports with 70 incidents reported; February had the fewest with 37.
- The Anna PD Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) clearance rate for 2013 offenses was 52%; 2012's was 53%. Of those incidents that were assigned to our Detectives for follow up, 66% were cleared.
- Citizens reported an estimated \$95,457 worth of property stolen in burglaries, larcenies, and auto thefts. The Department recovered an estimated \$15,083 in property.
- There were 287 adult arrests made by Anna PD during the reporting period compared to 281 for last year. Drunkenness, Intoxication Manslaughter, Drug Possession, Assault-Family Violence, Aggravated Assault, Theft and Burglary are just a few of the charges that were filed.
- Anna Police Investigated 152 Traffic Crashes in 2013 compared to 139 in 2012, a 9.35% increase. Distracted drivers are the most common reason for the occurrences of crashes as well as the increases in traffic volume in our jurisdiction. Of the 152 total, 35 involved injuries. There were 4 traffic fatalities.

- Anna Police wrote a total of 2,550 citations compared to 3,680 in 2012. Of all citations issued, 63% were warnings. Verbal warnings are not counted.
- Currently, Eleven (11) previously convicted sex-offenders are required to be registered with (and monitored by) the Police Department. Three (3) of those eleven are currently incarcerated as a result of cases that were filed by Anna PD.
- The Department continued to be heavily involved in the community by hosting both the National Night Out Community event and the Children's ID fair. Further, the Department continues to provide vacation/house watch services to our citizens. More than 2,000 special watches were conducted in 2013.
- Officers of the Anna Police Department confiscated or seized the following amounts of dangerous drugs:
